Registration Information

The registration fee for the 2011 SR-9 Conclave will be \$27 per participant if paid by March 31, 2011. Each lodge should write a check payable to the Flint River Council as explained on the Delegate and Memorabilia Pre-Order Form. After March 31, 2011, the fee will be \$45. A few delegates may be added later, but the last day to add a large number of delegates is April 7. This is to allow for proper food purchases.

Firm delegate and trading post orders are due February 4. Delegates registering after February 4 may not receive a delegate patch if there is a large increase in registrations. Additional trading post items may be added if inventory is available. A limited inventory will be available in the trading post at conclave.

Participants must be approved by their scout executive or lodge adviser and will pre-register through their lodge. Individual registrations will not be accepted. Individuals needing to register late will be checked in by their contingent leader.

The lodge adviser or his designated representative should plan to check in his contingent on-site on Friday, April 15. Please indicate the individual who will be responsible for the contingent on your Lodge Transmittal Form. The person designated to register each lodge will be expected to arrive as early as possible on Friday, April 15, hopefully prior to the bulk of his lodge's contingent. He will be directed to Howard Lodge to complete the registration process. He should turn in the attached roster with the appropriate information completed for each pre-registered participant and a photo-copied medical form for each pre-registered participant. He will receive the appropriate number of participant armbands for the contingent, which will be used for admission to all conclave events and dining. Anyone not wearing the armband may be asked to leave the camp property. All known late registrations will be handled at this time.

Awards

Each lodge should bring 9 lodge flaps to the **winter retreat** for section awards. Give these to Conclave Adviser, Mr. Chris Dunn.

Transportation

A map to Camp Thunder in Molena, Georgia is enclosed. Road signs will be placed to help direct you to camp. Please keep in mind that Camp Thunder, Lawhorn Scout Reservation is the Eastern Time Zone, so allow for the time difference in making your travel plans.

Parking

In order to make the check-in process smoother, each lodge will be assigned to a specific parking lot as close as possible to your site. After registration has ended and final campsite assignments have been made, you will receive a map that will direct you to your assigned lot. Lodges are encouraged to pack lodge gear together so it can be driven into your site in one of your "in site" vehicles. If not, Ini-To will have trailers available for transporting gear. It is preferred for lodges to arrive as a whole. By April 1, Ini-To needs an accurate estimate on the number of vehicles your lodge is bringing in order to ensure sufficient parking. We have a limited amount of parking in camp and only if all participants carpool, we will be able to park everyone in camp and can avoid having to park off site and bus people and gear into camp. If off-site parking is needed, it will be located at our second camp, approximately two miles away and you will be bussed to camp.

Each lodge will receive three (3) passes that will allow vehicles in the campsite. It is preferred that these be used for transporting gear. These vehicles, or if you have access to one, a golf cart or rhino type atv may also be used to transport any lodge members that may have disabilities that require transportation. If your lodge needs a handicapped pass please contact Conclave Adviser, Mr. Chris Dunn to make arrangements.

If your lodge needs to haul gear to another location in camp (for ceremonies or dance) your vehicle pass will allow you to do so. Please be advised that there is minimal parking in the area near the ceremony evaluation and the closest parking to the dance venue is several hundred yards uphill, please plan accordingly. Weather permitting, you will be able to drive to the ring and unload gear, but vehicles will then need to be moved back to the parking lot. If this is needed, please limit to one vehicle per lodge if possible.

All sites are accessible by vehicle. However, Alibamu and Aracoma will need a truck and or SUV to get to their site, and if it is a wet weekend, they will only be allowed four (4) wheel drive vehicles in the campsite. Ini-To can provide gear transportation if necessary.

Accommodations

Lodge campsites may be reassigned based on pre-registration delegate counts. As we finalize sites, the lodge will receive information on the exact number of tents/cabins/beds in the assigned site. All other delegates must bring their own tent. You will be notified by April 1 if tent or cot counts change. Each campsite features a bathhouse with toilettes and showers.

RV's are welcome, although they will be parked at our Flint River Area on the other side of the reservation and no hookups are available. Contact Conclave Adviser, Mr. Chris Dunn by April 1 to make arrangements to bring an RV.

As this is a large event, and we have limited housing, section officers will need to camp with their lodge. The section adviser and any special guest the section may bring will be provided lodging at the old camp office.

Each Campsite contains a trash can. Bagged trash should be set by the road in your site. Additional trash bags and toilette tissue is available at the information tent in front of Howard Lodge.

Emergency Contact Information

The number for camp is 706-647-9539. Please instruct family members of your participants to use this only in the event of an emergency. Be aware Verizon is the only cell provided with consistent service at Lawhorn Scout Reservation.

Food Service

Conclave meal service will begin at the Friday evening meal. If your lodge is arriving after the scheduled meal time on Friday and needs a later meal arrangements can be made. Special food needs may be requested and we will do our best to accommodate the request. Contact Conclave Adviser, Mr. Chris Dunn by April 1 for any late meal service or special needs. If your lodge does not need a meal at all on Friday night please let us know that as well.

Needs Lists

It is requested that the Section officers and CVCs send their needs lists to Conclave Chairman Sam Strawbridge by February 15. If you know earlier that you will need items, please let us know. The earlier the better. A Scout is Prepared!

Trading Post

The trading post hours of operation will be included in the schedule. Section items, as well as general Scout and camp merchandise, fountain drinks, ice cream, candy, snacks, etc. will be available. All pre-ordered section memorabilia will be sorted by lodge and distributed during registration to each lodge's contingent leader.

Please remember all 2011 conclave merchandise is sold by pre-order only. There will be a very limited supply of 2011 conclave merchandise available in the trading post.

Information Tent

Ini-To will have an information tent in front of Howard Lodge. It is our goal to be able to answer any and all conclave questions at this tent. There will be a display of schedule changes located in the Dining hall as well. We ask that all changes to the conclave program and schedule be communicated to the information tent. We will also have a large master schedule at the information tent so all conclave participants will know what has been changed in a timely manner.

SR-9 2011 CONCLAVE CODE OF CONDUCT

All participants and staff at the section conclave agree to abide by the following code of conduct. The general welfare of any group depends on the conduct of each individual member. This ensures the success of our section conclave and provides the maximum benefit to every participant. As an Arrowman, I understand this and support the reasonable demands of conduct expected of me.

As a participant of the 2011 SR-9 Conclave, and a member of the Order of the Arrow, Scouting's National Honor Society, I will:

- (1) Observe the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and the Obligation of the Order of the Arrow.
- (2) Understand that Scouting spirit and fellowship are best demonstrated by supporting the efforts of my lodge in a positive manner. I will respect the property of others, and will refrain from any inappropriate acts of ridicule, criticism or poor sportsmanship.
- (3) Confine the trading and swapping of patches to free time and designated areas.
- (4) Not be authorized to sell items at the conclave. I understand that the official trading post is the only source for purchasing items at the conclave.
- (5) Be personally responsible for breakage, damage or loss of property.
- (6) Respectfully observe quiet hours from midnight to 6:00 a.m.
- (7) Keep my quarters clean and dispose of trash in a proper place.
- (8) Understand that the purchase, possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs at the conclave will not be permitted and will result in immediate dismissal from the conclave. This standard shall apply to all youth and adult participants. Compliance with state and local law will apply at all times.
- (9) Follow the Camp Thunder's policy on smoking. We are a smoke-free property.
- (10) At all times, be a considerate guest of a considerate service lodge and council.
