CONFERENCE PLANNING MEETING

Delegates from the six area lodges met December 3, at Callaway Gardens to make basic preparations for the coming 1967 Area Conference, to be held April 21 - 23. Representing Immokalee Lodge were Mr. Josh Molder, Council Scout Executive, Gordon Reyher, Lodge Chief, and Greg Fullerton, Lodge Secretary-Treasurer. Main items of business at the planning conference were as follows:

1. Gordon Reyher was established as 1967 Area Vice-Chief.
2. The Area voting system was amended, giving each lodge one vote instead of two, as was the former procedure.
3. Immokalee will sponsor the cross country in the Quest for the Golden Arrow. Other events will include a Tug-of-War, canoe course, rope throw, flagpole raising, and fire building.
4. No programs will be held Sunday morning, April 23. A breakfast will be optional for all delegations.
5. Immokalee will host the camp-fire ceremonies Friday and Saturday nights.
6. Discussion groups will be held on Camp Promotion Indian crafts, elections, and year-round program.
7. Scrapbook competition will replace the bulletin board contest.

8. Conference fees will be \$6.00 per delegate, \$3.00 of which must be paid by at least March 15. The deadline for the remainder of the meeting is April 10.

9. Our lodge has been allotted room for 27 delegates at the Conference.
