



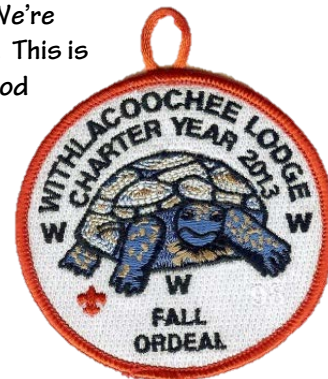
Withlacoochee Lodge Fall Ordeal & Fellowship
