

Arrowmen can celebrate the OA's 100th anniversary right now by working to complete the Arrowman Service Award (ASA). This award, or "the sash patch," will be recognized as one of the few patches that have ever been approved by the national committee to be worn on one's OA sash. The purposes of the ASA are to encourage Arrowmen

to recommit themselves to the ideals of the Order, strengthen their commitments to their local councils, and take part in the 100th anniversary events. The award will have 3 categories of criteria with various requirements that Arrowmen can complete. These include components on personal growth, service to Scouting, and participation in the centennial celebration. Members can begin working on the Arrowman Service Award right now and Arrowmen can continue working towards its completion through December 31st, 2015.

Annual membership dues for Withlacoochee Lodge is \$10.00.
